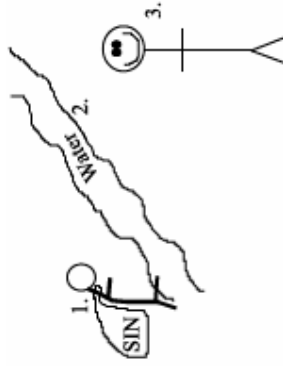
Praying for the Sick

Guidelines -- Luke 10:1-20

- a) Talk with the sick and with their family about the sickness.
- b) Listen to what the Holy Spirit tells you about the cause of the illness and what God wants to do for the sick person.
- c) Ask the sick if they have faith that Jesus can heal them.
- d) Ask permission to anoint the person with oil.
- e) Pray for the sick person in the name of Jesus.
- f) Ask God to heal them so that his glory would come to this home and they all would repent and be saved.
- g) Share the Good News and how God wants to heal them from the sickness of sin.
- h) Ask them if they want to repent and believe in Jesus. If yes, then baptize them and make a house church.

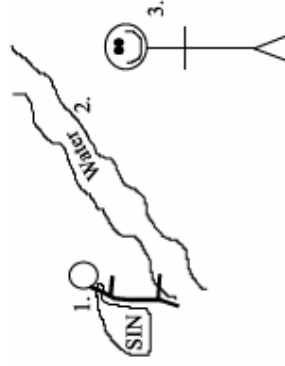

Making a House Church

Guidelines -- Luke 10:1-20

A simple definition of church is "Where
two or more are gathered in the name of
Jesus to obey all his commands in love."
After baptism, make a church by doing
this: 1. Appoint a leader. Typically,
every home will have a natural leader.
This is usually the father. 2. Ask the
leader if he will do his best to help his
church love and obey Jesus. 3. Ask all
the members of the church if they will
do their best to love and obey Jesus. 4.
Say a simple prayer like this: "Jesus
please help this church to love and obey
you, Amen"
